Opening hours and staffing situation – Friday 7th January

As mentioned in my previous letter, the staffing situation at Langa Street is critical this week, due to reasons including staff isolating or staff who have COVID-19 or are recovering. My priority is to offer safe and high quality care and education and it has been wonderful to see our children return this week, albeit with more limited hours than usual.

Unfortunately the situation is even more challenging tomorrow, therefore we have to further the limit the provision we can offer.

- On Friday 7th January, we will only be open for children who have parents who are working and have no other childcare option (i.e. both parents are working and other care arrangements are not feasible).
- We will be open from 8.30am to 4.00pm (morning session 8.30-12.30, afternoon session 1.00-4.00pm, full days session a maximum of 8.30am 4.00pm)

If you would like your child to attend tomorrow and all the adults in your household are working, please email me explaining clearly your situation as soon as possible at headteacher@langastreetnursery.glasgow.sch.uk to get confirmation from me that we can offer a place for your child tomorrow.

I am unable to receive lots of phone calls today due to our staffing situation however if you email me any questions of queries I will respond today

This is of course very regrettable, however I have some confidence that we can return to more like normal service next week. We may not be able to offer full hours next week but I certainly intend to offer provision to all of our families in some way.
